

MINUTES, LIMESTONE COUNTY COMMISSION, FEBRUARY 11, 2015

The Limestone County Commission reconvened the meeting from February 2, 2015 at 10:00 a.m. today at the Washington Street Courthouse Annex, 310 West Washington Street, Athens, AL.

Present: Stanley Hill, Steve Turner, Jason Black, and Ben Harrison. Absent: None. Mark Yarbrough, Chairman presided.

Commissioner Stanley Hill expressed his appreciation to ALDOT for the partial funding for resurfacing Thach Road. He also stated the Town of Ardmore has purchased property to build a new Senior Center.

Commissioner Steve Turner gave updates on the East Limestone Senior Center and the French's Mill bridge project, stating they are both on schedule for completion.

Commissioner Jason Black said Senator Holtzclaw and Madison Mayor Trulock are willing to purchase two emergency sirens for the portion of Madison City that is located in Limestone County.

Commissioner Ben Harrison stated the asphalt on Morris Road is complete. He also said he will work with the core of engineers and TVA to mitigate the debris pile up at the Easter Ferry Bridge.
