

MINUTES, LIMESTONE COUNTY COMMISSION, FEBRUARY 27, 2015

The Limestone County Commission reconvened the meeting from February 17, 2015 at 10:00 a.m. today at the Washington Street Courthouse Annex, 310 West Washington Street, Athens, AL.

Present: Stanley Hill, Steve Turner, Jason Black, and Ben Harrison. Absent: None. Mark Yarbrough, Chairman presided.

Commissioner Hill said appreciates the job the D1 employees did during the inclement weather. We will be patching and fixing pot holes as soon as the weather warms up.

Commissioner Turner said that he can't say enough about how hard the District 2 employees worked during the inclement weather. He gave an update on the East Limestone Senior Center project and the Mooresville Road Bridge ATRIP project.

Commissioner Black thanked his foreman, Tom Hill, and all the District 3 employees for their hard work during the inclement weather. He said constituents had called thanking him for the good job done by his employees.

Commissioner Harrison commended the District 4 employees for the hard work and extra effort during the inclement weather.

Chairman Yarbrough stated he was pleased with all four districts for the outstanding job in clearing the roads of the snow. He commended EMA Director, Rita White, along with Daphne Ellison and Eddie Gilbert for their hard work during the inclement weather. He said that he had received a call from John Cooper with ALDOT late Tuesday telling him that all projects, including the ATRIP projects, in Senator Holtzclaw's district are on hold. There are 6 projects in Senator's Holtzclaw's district; 1) Resurface Thach Road from I-65 to Highway 251, 2) Resurface East Limestone Road from Hwy 72 to Copeland Road, 3) Intersection improvements at Capshaw Road and East Limestone Road, 4) Add lane on East Limestone Road from Elkins Road to East Limestone School, 5) Bridge replace on Thach Road over unnamed bridge, and 6) Bridge replacement on Liberty Lane over Little Limestone Creek. Although we are disappointed, we hope a resolution will be reached to the satisfaction of the Governor and Senator Holtzclaw.

Items were discussed for the March 2, 2015 agenda.
