

MINUTES, LIMESTONE COUNTY COMMISSION, APRIL 30, 2014

The Limestone County Commission reconvened the meeting from April 21, 2014 at 10:00 a.m. today at the Washington Street Courthouse Annex, 310 West Washington Street, Athens, AL.

Present: Gary Daly, James W. "Bill" Latimer, and Ben Harrison. Absent: Steve Turner. Stanley Menefee, Chairman presided.

Items were discussed for the May 5, 2014 agenda.

Chairman Menefee announced the Farmers Market will open beginning May 6th, each Tuesday and Friday.

Chairman Menefee said the Clinton Street Annex was closed Tuesday due to no electricity after the storms.

Chairman Menefee stated that Governor Bentley will be at Billy Barb Trailer Park at 10:00 and Clements Fire Department today at 11:15 accessing storm damage.

Limestone County Commission appreciates Madison County for sending equipment and workers to help with storm clean-up.
