

MINUTES, LIMESTONE COUNTY COMMISSION, JULY 15, 2015

The Limestone County Commission reconvened the meeting from July 6, 2015 at 10:00 a.m. today at the Washington Street Courthouse Annex, 310 West Washington Street, Athens, AL.

Present: Stanley Hill, Steve Turner, Jason Black, and Ben Harrison. Chairman Mark Yarbrough presided.

Items were discussed for the July 20, 2015 agenda.

Commissioner Stanley Hill reported that his district had finished chip sealing Fain Road. He thanked each Commissioner for sending their dump trucks and the citizens for their patience.

Commissioner Steve Turner gave an update on the house on Pepper Road that was abandoned after the 2011 tornadoes. The Judge declared the house a nuisance in accordance with the Junk and Debris Act and has ordered the county to demolish the house.

Commissioner Jason Black discussed the law pertaining to campaign signage on the county right of way. He said that District 3 will be removing all signs on the county right of way.

Commissioner Ben Harrison requested to add the Rules of Procedures to Monday's agenda for consideration to amend.

Chairman Mark Yarbrough announced the Commission meetings would be live streamed beginning July 20th.

MOTION was made by Stanley Hill and seconded by Steve Turner to enter into executive session to discuss the good name and character of an employee.

Chairman Mark Yarbrough asked if there was any discussion. There was no discussion. The Administrator called the roll. Stanley Hill, aye; Steve Turner, aye, Jason Black, aye; and Ben Harrison, aye. Motion carries unanimously.
