

MINUTES, LIMESTONE COUNTY COMMISSION, JULY 30, 2014

The Limestone County Commission reconvened the meeting from July 21, 2014 at 10:00 a.m. today at the Washington Street Courthouse Annex, 310 West Washington Street, Athens, AL.

Present: Gary Daly, James W. "Bill" Latimer, and Ben Harrison. Absent: Steve Turner. Stanley Menefee, Chairman presided.

Bill Giguere from the Mental Health of North Central Alabama presented their FY 2015 budget appropriation request of \$80,000.00.

Susan McGrady from the Athens/Limestone Children's Advocacy Center presented their FY 2015 budget appropriation request of \$35,000.00.

Trisha Black from the Spirit of Athens presented their FY 2015 budget appropriation request of \$25,000.00, with request of \$2,500.00 for the Athens Grease Festival for current fiscal year.

MOTION was made by Gary Daly and seconded by Ben Harrison to suspend the Rules of Order to take action on polling location and precinct line changes.

The Chairman called the roll. Gary Daly, aye; James W. "Bill" Latimer, aye; and Ben Harrison, aye. Motion carries unanimously.

MOTION was made by Gary Daly and seconded by James W. "Bill" Latimer to approve the following polling location and precinct line changes:

- The polling location for Precinct 0302 move from Johnson Elementary to Mays Memorial Baptist Church (1,573 registered voters).
- Creekside Elementary located within Beat 02 to no longer be used as a polling location for Precinct 0202.
- Precinct lines in Beat 2 divided into four precincts instead of three precincts and add a new polling location:
 1. Precinct 0201 Isom's Chapel United Methodist Church (2,650 registered voters)
 2. Precinct 0202 Copeland Presbyterian Church (2,270 registered voters)
 3. Precinct 0203 Capshaw Baptist Church (3,490 registered voters)
 4. Precinct 0204 Bethel Church of Christ (2,610 registered voters)

The Chairman asked if there was any discussion. There was no discussion. The Chairman called the roll. Gary Daly, aye; James W. "Bill" Latimer, aye; and Ben Harrison, aye. Motion carries unanimously.
