

MINUTES, LIMESTONE COUNTY COMMISSION, AUGUST 1, 2012

The Limestone County Commission reconvened the meeting from July 19, 2012 at 10:00 a.m. today at the Washington Street Courthouse Annex, 310 West Washington Street, Athens, AL.

Present: Gary Daly, Gerald Barksdale, James W. "Bill" Latimer, and Bill Daws. Absent: None. Stanley Menefee, Chairman presided.

Trisha Black from Spirit of Athens requested approval to use the pavilion at the Limestone County Farmers Market to host the market on Saturdays starting in April, 2013.

Rex Davis, 16844 Linton Road, Athens, AL voiced his concerns in regards to the Athens Limestone Public Library project.

Chairman Menefee stated that he discussed with County Attorney Mark Maclin the continued renting to the commercial and residential tenants at the L & S property. Mark advised the County had to charge fair market value for the rent; he would expect to have fair market value by Monday.

The hours of operation for the Limestone County Farmers Market were discussed and the possibility of hiring someone through the County to oversee it.

Chairman Menefee stated that he discussed with Brian Moore the Courthouse project. The architect should have plans 75% complete by August 14, 2012, but Martin & Cobey Construction could go ahead and bid the project at 75% completion.
