

MINUTES, LIMESTONE COUNTY COMMISSION, OCTOBER 16, 2013

The Limestone County Commission reconvened the meeting from October 7, 2013 at 10:00 a.m. today at the Washington Street Courthouse Annex, 310 West Washington Street, Athens, AL.

Present: Gary Daly, Steve Turner, James W. "Bill" Latimer, and Ben Harrison. Absent: None. Stanley Menefee, Chairman presided.

Lora Weaver with the Northeast Alabama Traffic Office presented the Yellow Dot program that is funded by the Alabama Department of Economic and Community Affairs/Law Enforcement Traffic Safety Division and is being administered by the Northeast Alabama Traffic Office. The Yellow Dot program is designed to assist Alabama citizens and first responders in the event of an automobile crash or other medical emergency involving the participant's vehicle. She explained how the program can help save lives during the critical "golden hour" by improving communication at a time when accident victims may be unable to communicate for themselves.
