

MINUTES, LIMESTONE COUNTY COMMISSION, DECEMBER 31, 2014

The Limestone County Commission reconvened the meeting from December 19, 2014 at 10:00 a.m. today at the Washington Street Courthouse Annex, 310 West Washington Street, Athens, AL.

Present: Stanley Hill, Steve Turner, Jason Black, and Ben Harrison. Absent: None. Mark Yarbrough, Chairman presided.

Judy Montgomery, Jane Pointer and Willie Birkhead requested something be done about the McCulley Mill and Pepper Road intersection, stating there have been four wrecks there in a six-month period.

County Engineer Richard Sanders said a traffic count report that includes speed is being conducted, and he should have a recommendation within the next two weeks.

Commissioner Steve Turner stated he will get with Sheriff Blakely to request more patrol for the area.

Commissioner Stanley Hill gave an update on the activities in District 1; including patching and repairing erosion from heavy rains, burying large animals and replacing tin on the tool shed roof.

Commissioner Steve Turner gave an update on the East Limestone Senior Center and requested adding a Change Order to Monday's agenda for doors and grinding a hump in the middle of the floor. He also said the French's Mill bridge project is still progressing.

Commissioner Jason Black thanked the District 3 employees for working on Christmas Eve and Christmas morning to repair some pot holes as a result of the heavy rain.

Chairman Yarbrough thanked everyone for coming and wished everyone a safe and happy New Year.
