

MINUTES, LIMESTONE COUNTY COMMISSION, OCTOBER 28, 2015

The Limestone County Commission reconvened the meeting from October 19, 2015 at 10:00 a.m. today at the Washington Street Courthouse Annex, 310 West Washington Street, Athens, AL.

Present: Stanley Hill, Steve Turner, Jason Black, and Ben Harrison. Absent: None. Mark Yarbrough, Chairman presided.

Dr. Robert Keith Hill respectfully requested the commission to reconsider Athens Limestone Hospital's budgetary appropriations for this fiscal year.

Assistant County Engineer Marc Massey requested the commission to consider buying a new tar truck/asphalt spreader at an approximate cost of \$165,000 to \$175,000.

Commissioner Stanley Hill said that most of the phone calls he receives from citizens is in regard to when will be Courthouse renovations be finished. He said he would like to see that happen as soon as possible.

Commissioner Steve Turner asked the commissioners to think about the possibility to streamline by storing oil, grease, etc. at their own tool sheds.

Commissioner Jason Black discussed a spraying program for roadsides and bridges that would reduce cutting to one time a year.

Commissioner Ben Harrison proposed setting a travel budget for commissioners who are appointed to boards.

Items were discussed for the November 2, 2015 agenda.
