- 1. Approve the following Change Orders for Phase III of the Courthouse renovation project; \$18,676.17
 - Garber Time and Material Structural Repairs is for the sixth draw for the Structural Repairs to the walls, floors, doorways and elevator repair. This includes work on rebuilding metal stud walls removed during structural repairs, masonry work at elevator openings, and structural repairs to elevator shaft walls and headers; \$13,836.66
 - Garber T&M Cost for Demolition @ Rooms 017 & 043 removal of one wall in Circuit Court Clerk's Vault and one in the District Attorney's area; These walls were in the areas on the North and South ends of the building that are under the stoops of the exterior steps; <u>\$307.63</u>
 - Veep Electric CO#8 MCM lugs had to be changed by the manufacturer in order for panel to work as designed; <u>\$345.00</u>
