

MINUTES, LIMESTONE COUNTY COMMISSION, JUNE 14, 2016

The Limestone County Commission reconvened the meeting from June 7, 2016 at 10:00 a.m. today at the Washington Street Courthouse Annex, 310 West Washington Street, Athens, AL.

Present: Stanley Hill, Jason Black, and Ben Harrison. Absent: Steve Turner. Mark Yarbrough, Chairman presided.

Ann Coleman and Brett McGill presented a pricing proposal from Calhoun Community College Workforce Solutions for a CPR/First Aid Alignment Program:

Train the Trainer	\$3,750.00
Annual Alignment Fee	\$50.00/Instruction (included in first year)
CPD card processing	\$7.00/Person

Jason Black presented a second proposal from Tommy Toone Jr. for CPR/AED training at \$35.00 per person plus \$20.00 per book.

Assistant County Engineer Marc Massey discussed that federal aid funds for this year took a \$50,000.00 hit, reducing funds from \$533,000.00 to \$483,000.00.

Commissioner Hill thanked Sabrina Bates, Accounts Payable/Purchasing Clerk, for her understanding and working with the new commissioners. He said, "She will be missed", as she moves to her new position as Assistant Director for Council on Aging.

Commissioners Harrison discussed the ACCA Liability Self Insurance Fund, Inc. property program that is being offered to the counties that participate in the ACCA liability fund. He requested a copy of the County's property insurance policies be sent to Henry Van Arken at the ACCA.

Chairman Yarbrough announced that representatives from Rexel and Phillips Kinetics will perform a mock-up demonstration of a colored lighting system for the Courthouse on June 16th at 8:30 pm.
