**INVITATION TO BID  
Proposal Number 2594**

Sealed bids will be received by the Limestone County Commission Office, which is located at 310 West Washington Street, Athens, Alabama 35611 until **Ten o'clock a.m. Tuesday, September 27, 2016.** At that time, bids will be publicly opened. Bids will be awarded at the regularly scheduled Limestone County Commission Meeting at ten o'clock a.m. on Monday, October 3, 2016.

**CONTRACT PERIOD:** The contract shall cover the County's requirements of "Bituminous Treatment Resurfacing" from October 4, 2016 through September 30, 2017. In the event that the company receiving the bid cannot furnish the County's needs at the time of the request, the Limestone County Commission reserves the right to purchase from other sources.

Bids may be mailed to the Limestone County Commission Office at the address above, or may be hand delivered to the same address between the hour of 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday. It should be noted on your envelope **BID ENCLOSED FOR BITUMINOUS TREATMENT RESURFACING.**

All bids shall conform with the requirements of the Competitive Bid Law (Act No. 217) of the Special Session of the 1967 Alabama Legislature and subsequent acts concerning competitive bidding on contracts for State and Local Agencies through Act No. 95-630 of the 1995 Alabama Legislature Session.

The Limestone County Commission reserves the right to reject any and/or all bids, or portions of bids; bid awards will always be in the best interest of Limestone County Commission. Questions concerning specifications, bids, and submission should be directed to J. Bryant Moss, County Engineer.

The right to award portions of this bid to separate bidders is reserved by the Limestone County Commission; this being stated; it is the expressed intent of the Limestone County Commission to award the contract as a whole to one (1) successful bidder should all prices remain competitive.

Bids will be accepted based on the price index per gallon of asphalt as determined by the Alabama Department of Transportation asphalt index for the month of September 2016. Any increase or decrease in asphalt prices will be determined and adjusted by the price index for the month purchased.

RESPONSIBILITY FOR DAMAGE CLAIMS

The Contractor shall indemnify and save harmless Limestone County, the Limestone County Commission, the officers and employees from all suits, actions, or claims of any character brought because of any injuries or damages received or sustained by any person, persons, or property on account of the operations of the said Contractor; or through use of unacceptable materials in constructing the work; or because of any act or omission, neglect, or misconduct of said Contractor; or because of any claims or amounts arising or recovered under the Workman's Compensation Act or any other law, ordinance, order, or decree.

It shall be the bidder's responsibility to possess all proper County, State, and Federal License and to familiarize himself with and shall comply with all Federal, State, and Local laws, ordinances, and regulations.


Bids must be submitted on the bid form provided.

Bids must be submitted either by mail or in person, however, Limestone County will not be responsible for the security of mailed bids.

NOTES/GENERAL PROVISIONS

1. Please check and make sure bid is signed in the space provided. The right to reject any and all bids is hereby reserved.
2. A minimum of 20,000 Sq. Yds. of paving, resurfacing or strip patching, will be done on each mobilization of equipment to Limestone County however, the minimum of 20,000 Sq. Yds. May be in more than one location in Limestone County.
3. A \$5,000.00 Bid Bond or Cashiers check shall be submitted with bid.
4. A \$100,000.00 Performance Bond, covering a period of one year, shall be submitted before any work is started.
5. Proof of Liability Insurance and Workman's Compensation Insurance shall be submitted before any work is started. The General Liability Insurance shall be a minimum of \$500,000.
6. Test reports shall be submitted on all materials before Final Payment will be made.
7. Work shall begin within thirty days after Notice to Proceed is issued.
8. All Surface Treatments shall be swept for the final time within 3 working days of the last day's placement of the work on the purchase order, unless otherwise directed by the Engineer. The penalty for not sweeping within the specified time shall be \$5,000.00 a day until the work is performed, with the penalty charged as a reduction in pay on the purchase order.

9. Pay estimates shall be submitted monthly and payment shall be made at the next regular County Commission meeting after submission and verification of estimates.
10. All bids shall be good from October 4, 2016 thru September 30, 2017.
11. These bids shall be good for other governmental agencies located in Limestone County.
12. Materials and work performed shall meet the current requirements of the Alabama Department of Transportation Standard Specifications, 2012 Edition.
13. Pursuant to Alabama Code 31-13-9, as a condition of the award of any contract, the business entity or employer, and any of its subcontractors, shall provide a sworn affidavit and documentation that it will not knowingly employ, hire for employment, or continue to employ an unauthorized alien; that it is enrolled in the E-Verify program; and, during the contract period, it will participate in the E-Verify program and will verify every employee that is required to be verified under applicable state and federal laws. During the performance of the contract, the business entity or employer shall participate in the E-Verify program and shall verify every employee that is required to be verified according to the applicable federal rules and regulations.
