

LIMESTONE COUNTY COMMISSION, OCTOBER 17, 2022
WORK SESSION MINUTES

The Limestone County Commission reconvened the meeting from October 3, 2022 at 9:00 a.m. at the Clinton Street Courthouse Annex, 100 South Clinton Street, Athens, Alabama.

Present: Daryl Sammet, Danny Barksdale, Jason Black, and LaDon Townsend. Absent: None. Collin Daly, Chairman presided.

Items were discussed for today's commission meeting.

Chairman Daly informed the Commission that TARCOG was conducting the grant for the wastewater improvements for Pryor Field Regional Airport, and due to Pryor Field being located in Limestone County, the grant us to be run through the Limestone County Commission. Commissioner Black and Marc Massey discussed a light being placed in that area, and Engineer Massey stated that a traffic study was being performed.

Chairman Daly informed the Commission that Amendment 2 will allow ARPA funds for broadband expansion.
