

**LIMESTONE COUNTY COMMISSION, DECEMBER 19, 2022,
WORK SESSION MINUTES**

The Limestone County Commission reconvened the meeting from December 5, 2022 at 9:00 a.m. at the Clinton Street Courthouse Annex, 100 South Clinton Street, Athens, Alabama.

Present: Daryl Sammet, Danny Barksdale, LaDon Townsend, and Derrick Gatlin. Absent: None. Collin Daly, Chairman presided.

Items were discussed for today's commission meeting.

The Chairman stated that on No.3 under "Contracts, Agreements, MOUs, and Grants" the ending date should be September 30, 2023 instead of September 30, 2022.

Commissioner Barksdale inquired as to the breakdown of the budget revision listed for Recycling at the L & S Property. There was extensive discussion regarding same and the possible plans for the future of the L & S Property.

Attorney Drew Dill informed the Commission that there would be no conflict of interest for Commissioner Gatlin to place a vote as to Commissioner Gatlin's placement on the E911 Board of Commissioners due to the fact that there is not a monetary benefit for participation on the E911 Board of Commissioners.

There was discussion regarding the awarding of the bid for the video arraignment system for the Sheriff's Office.

Chairman Daly informed the Commission that the State pays 50% of the Assistant Engineer's position.

As to the approval of the purchase of ten (10) 16' Stampede 21 CY truck beds, Chairman Daly informed the Commission, it was necessary to go ahead and place on the agenda so that the order for same can be placed for same.
