

LIMESTONE COUNTY COMMISSION, FEBRUARY 6, 2023
WORK SESSION MINUTES

The Limestone County Commission reconvened the meeting from January 17, 2023 at 9:00 a.m. at the Clinton Street Courthouse Annex, 100 South Clinton Street, Athens, Alabama.

Present: Daryl Sammet, Danny Barksdale, Derrick Gatlin, and LaDon Townsend. Absent: None. Chairman Collin Daly presided.

Items were discussed for today's commission meeting.

Engineer Marc Massey informed the Commission that the resolution for the setting of a public hearing on March 20, 2023 is being conducted so that ADEM can begin the process for the re-building of a structure at 16100 BFI Lane due to the structure being destroyed by fire.

Chairman Daly informed the Commission that the budget revision listed for the Commission office was due to the replacement of the boiler.

There was discussion regarding the Solid Waste Department budget.

As to awarding of the concrete pipe bid, the amount listed is an estimated total, and the price is not per pipe, and the inmate county healthcare services will be for 24-hour services.
