INVITATION FOR BIDS Proposal No. 2870

GUARDRAILS AND END ANCHORS

Notice is hereby given that the Commission of Limestone County, Alabama will receive competitive bids on the following items:

GUARDRAIL AND END ANCHORS. SEE ATTACHED SPECIFICATIONS.

This bid is effective from October 1, 2024, until September 30, 2025.

Date of Delivery: AS REQUESTED. Terms: NET 30 DAYS.

You are invited to bid on the attached specifications. Any substitutes offered must be submitted in detail. The right to reject any items or materials not of quality or under any provisions of applicable Alabama law is reserved.

Proposals <u>must</u> <u>be received</u> by 10:00 a.m., CST, on Tuesday, September 10, 2024. Late proposals shall not be considered. Deliver sealed proposals by hand, U.S. Mail, or commercial courier service to:

Fax and/or electronically delivered (e.g., by email) proposals shall not be accepted.

Bids will be opened on **Tuesday**, the **10**th day of **September 2024**, at **10:00 a.m.** and awarded on **Monday**, the **16**th day of **September 2024**, at the regular meeting of the Limestone County Commission, which will follow a work session at **10:00 a.m.**

REQUIREMENTS:

SECTION 1: GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1.1 <u>Bid Package</u>: All Bids must be clearly marked on the outside of a sealed envelope "Guardrails and End Anchors." Further, the outside of the envelope shall also be clearly marked with the proposal number and opening date.
- 1.2 <u>Award</u>: Award will be made to the most responsive, responsible bid meeting specifications, which presents the product and/or service which is in the best interest of Limestone County. Limestone County reserves the right to reject any or all bids for any reason. Bidder shall bid its prices for each material using Attachment 1, which is attached to this Invitation for Bids. Bidder must provide prices for each category of material listed in Attachment 1 or its bid may be determined to be non-compliant with this Invitation for Bids. <u>All applicable taxes must be included in the amount of bid price</u>.
- 1.3 <u>Copies</u>: Limestone County requires that bids be submitted with 1 original and 5 copies.
- 1.4 <u>Signing of Bids</u>: In order to be considered, all bids must be signed by an officer of the bidding company.
- 1.5 <u>Contractor Default</u>: Limestone County reserves the right, in the case of Bidder default under an awarded bid, to procure the articles or services from other sources and hold the defaulting vendor responsible for any excess cost occasioned thereby.
- 1.6 <u>Waiving of Informalities</u>: Limestone County reserves the right to waive informalities or technicalities in any bids when in the best interest of Limestone County.

SECTION 2: OBLIGATIONS, RIGHTS, AND REMEDIES

- 2.1 <u>Alterations and Amendments</u>: No alterations, amendments, changes, modifications, or additions to this request shall be binding on Limestone County without the prior written approval of the County.
- 2.2 <u>Compliance with all Laws</u>: Bidder is assumed to be familiar with and agrees to observe and comply with all federal, state, and local laws, statutes, ordinances, and regulations in any manner affecting the provision of goods and/or services, and all instructions and prohibitive orders issued regarding this work. Bidder shall provide proof of appropriate licensing and permits in the State of Alabama upon request. If Bidder's Bid is awarded, then Bidder shall make all reports, as necessary, to any and all federal, state, and local entities, if and as required.
- 2.3 <u>Governing Laws</u>: The laws of the State of Alabama shall govern this Invitation for Bids, and all obligations of the parties will be performable in Limestone County, Alabama. The courts of Limestone County, Alabama, shall have jurisdiction over any disputes which arise hereunder and the courts in such jurisdiction shall be the exclusive venue for any claims, suits, or actions by either party.
- 2.4 <u>Indemnification/Hold Harmless</u>: The Bidder who is awarded a contract for the provision of the described services and/or goods, shall indemnify, defend, save and hold harmless the Limestone County Commission, its officers, agents, and employees from all suits, claims, actions

or damages of any nature brought because of, arising out of, or due to breach of the awarded contract, its subcontractors, suppliers, agents, or employees, or due to any negligent act or occurrence, or any omission or commission of Bidder, its subcontractors, suppliers, agents or employees.

2.5 <u>Nondiscrimination and Statement</u>: Bidder agrees that no person on the grounds of handicap, age, race, color, religion, sex, or national origin, shall be excluded from participation in, or be denied benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination in the performance of any contract awarded pursuant to this request, or in the employment practices of Bidder.

SECTION 3: SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 3.1 <u>Intent</u>: The Limestone County Commission is requesting bids from interested and qualified vendors for providing Guardrails and End Anchors to the Limestone County Commission which meets the specifications in this Invitation for Bids, including, but not limited to, all related requirements set forth in this Invitation for Bids and this Section 3.
- 3.2 <u>Term</u>: The effective term of the awarded bid is from October 1, 2024 to September 30, 2025.
- 3.3 <u>Compliance with All Applicable Regulations</u>: The successful Bidder agrees and covenants that the company, its agents and employees will comply with all codes, laws, rules, and regulations applicable to the business conducted pursuant to any awarded bid.
- 3.4 <u>Delivery of Services</u>: Bidder shall deliver all goods and/or services as described in this Invitation for Bids, including, but not limited to, in the attachment(s) to this Invitation for Bids. Limestone County reserves the right to reject any non-conforming materials.
- 3.5 <u>Time for Work to Begin</u>: Time is of the essence in any work performed pursuant to an award of bid. Unless otherwise agreed upon, the Bidder shall begin work no later than 20 days after the work order has been submitted. Work shall be prosecuted in a continuous manner until completion. In the event work has not started within 20 working days and/or work is not prosecuted in a diligent and continuous manner, the bid may be canceled and placed with the bidder whose price is the next acceptable bid above the lowest acceptable bid received. The difference in cost accrued in the change from the bid price to the next acceptable bid price above that of the low bidder may be charged as liquidated damages to the bidder failing to accomplish the work as described above, except where delays are due to causes beyond the control of the contractor.
- 3.6 <u>Traffic Control</u>: Contractor will be responsible for traffic control and protection of the placed material from traffic.
- 3.7 <u>Compliance with ALDOT Specifications</u>: All materials furnished and installation of said materials shall comply with the State of Alabama Department of Transportation Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2022 Edition and to the ALDOT Special and Standard Highway Drawings, (Latest Edition). Special attention is directed to Section 630.00 of the Specifications.
- 3.8 <u>Full Compensation</u>: The price bid for the anchors and guardrail shall be full compensation for furnishing all materials, equipment, tools, labor, and incidentals necessary to

complete removal and installation according to section 630.03 of the Specifications. Payment shall be made under section 630.05 of the Specifications.

- 3.9 <u>Reporting</u>: All material testing, certifications, test reports, etc. as required by the Specifications shall be provided by the contractor to the Limestone County Engineering Department.
- 3.10 <u>Salvage</u>: Any salvageable materials shall remain property of Limestone County Commission.
- 3.11 <u>Bid Calculations</u>: Quantities on Bid Sheet (Attachment 1) are estimates for determining low bidder only. Actual quantities to be placed will vary significantly from quantities shown. Bid will be awarded to one contractor based on the lowest total bid for all items based on the estimated quantities.
- 3.12 Anti-Boycott Requirements: Bidder avers that it is not currently engaged in, and during the duration of any agreement with Limestone County shall not engage in, the boycott of any person or entity based in or doing business with a jurisdiction with which Alabama can enjoy open trade. If bid is awarded, then Bidder shall complete and execute a Certificate of Compliance with Act 2016-312, as provided to it by Limestone County.
- 3.13 Anti-Economic Boycotts Requirements: If Bidder is a company with 10 or more full-time employees, the Bidder avers that, without violating controlling law and when not excepted by Alabama Code (1975) § 41-16-161(c), it does not, and shall not during the duration of any agreement between it and Limestone County, engage in economic boycotts. If awarded a contract pursuant to this request, then Bidder (if a company with 10 or more full-time employees) shall complete and execute a Certificate of Compliance with Act 2023-409, as provided to it by Limestone County.
- 3.14 Beason-Hammon Taxpayer and Citizen Protection Act Requirements: By submitting a Bid and/or by entering into an agreement with Limestone County pursuant to an award based on this Invitation for Bids, then Bidder affirms, for the duration of any such agreement, that it will not violate federal immigration law or knowingly employ, hire for employment, or continue to employ an unauthorized alien within the State of Alabama. Furthermore, a party found to be in violation of this provision shall be deemed in breach of the agreement formed and shall be responsible for all damages resulting therefrom. Moreover, Bidder shall provide documentary proof to Limestone County that it participates in the E-Verify program. If the Bid submitted pursuant to this Invitation for Bids is awarded by Limestone County, then Bidder shall complete and execute a Certificate of Compliance with the Beason-Hammon Alabama Taxpayer and Citizen Protection Act, as provided to it by Limestone County.

SECTION 4: COMPANY INFORMATION
