MINUTES, LIMESTONE COUNTY COMMISSION, JULY 11, 2018

The Limestone County Commission reconvened the meeting from July 2, 2018 at 10:00 a.m. today at the Washington Street Courthouse Annex, 310 West Washington Street, Athens, AL.

Present: Steve Turner, Jason Black, and Ben Harrison. Absent: Stanley Hill. Mark Yarbrough, Chairman presided.

Tina Cook presented an appropriation request for the FY19 budget in the amount of \$20,000.00 plus monthly utility cost for the Family Resource Center.

County Engineer Bryant Moss discussed the Burgreen Road and Dupree Worthy Road intersections at Highway 72. He said the Commission may want to consider passing a resolution to request the Alabama Department of Transportation to conduct a traffic study. He said a possible option could be to consider right turn lanes only at each intersection.

Items were discussed for the July 16, 2018 agenda.

Commissioner Turner will be requesting approval to stripe Mooresville Road from Huntsville-Brownsferry Road to US Highway 72, and resurface and stripe turn lane at Rolling Vista Drive and Grove Hill Lane; total project cost \$46,500 with 50% reimbursed by the City of Athens. He reported his district has finished bush hogging north of Highway 72 and will be moving to the southside.

Commissioner Black will be requesting approval for center and edge line striping for Huntsville-Brownsferry Road from Snake Road to Highway 31; total project cost \$24,522.

Commissioner Harrison requested to add the following items to the agenda to sell on GovDeals.

- (2) generators
- John Deere bull dozer
- Roll Back

MOTION was made by Jason Black and seconded by Ben Harrison to approve to enter Executive Session to discuss a matter of personnel.

The Chairman asked if there was any discussion. There was no discussion. The Administrator called the roll. Jason Black, aye; Ben Harrison, aye; and Steve Turner, aye. Motion carries unanimously.
