

## **MINUTES, LIMESTONE COUNTY COMMISSION, OCTOBER 31, 2018**

The Limestone County Commission reconvened the meeting from October 15, 2018 at 10:00 a.m. today at the Washington Street Courthouse Annex, 310 West Washington Street, Athens, AL.

Present: Stanley Hill, Steve Turner, Jason Black, and Ben Harrison. Absent: None. Mark Yarbrough, Chairman presided.

Commissioner Steve Turner presented the commission with copies of the proposed resolution for the severance tax distribution.

Items were discussed for the November 5, 2018 agenda.

Stanley Hill reported that his district is performing routine maintenance. He said, "This is my last and final work session." He expressed his appreciation for all the help and support he has received throughout the years.

Steve Turner discussed the concerns about the crosswalk from East Limestone High School to TAB's Market. To improve safety, he has ordered pedestrian crossing signs with LED lights embedded in the sign with a button that must be pressed to activate the warning flashers.

Jason Black reported his district is working on Airport Road and cleaning out ditches. He said, on Friday his crew will be making the last round of bush hogging for the season.

Ben Harrison reported his district is working on Witty Mill Road. He requested to add the following items to Monday's agenda: 1) to allow the property owner at the end of Al Roberts Road to install a water line; 2) to act on the request to change the name of Seaman Road to Big Creek Road.
