

## **MINUTES, LIMESTONE COUNTY COMMISSION, JANUARY 31, 2018**

The Limestone County Commission reconvened the meeting from January 17, 2018 at 10:00 a.m. today at the Washington Street Courthouse Annex, 310 West Washington Street, Athens, AL.

Present: Stanley Hill, Steve Turner, and Jason Black. Absent: Ben Harrison. Mark Yarbrough, Chairman presided.

Items were discussed for the February 5, 2018 agenda.

Commissioner Hill: reported his district is busy making repairs to chip seal roads that were destroyed by the harsh weather.

Commissioner Turner: reported his district is patching potholes and cleaning ditches.

Commissioner Black: gave a report on Airport Road and said his district is repairing potholes. He said Coroner, Mike West, had talked with him about the need to purchase a cooler to store up to 6 to 8 bodies. The Coroner is currently using the local funeral homes; which only have space to store 4 bodies, and that is no longer sufficient due to the growing population.

Chairman Yarbrough: proposed creating a position under the maintenance department to assist with cleaning of the former judicial building when Community Corrections and the Council on Aging move to the building. He would like for this person to also assist with elections instead of pulling employees from the engineering department.
