

PROCLAMATION OF EXISTENCE OF A LOCAL EMERGENCY

LIMESTONE COUNTY COMMISSION

WHEREAS, an adopted Resolution, (in accordance with State Law) by the County of Limestone empowers the Limestone County Commission to proclaim the existence of a local emergency when the County is affected or likely to be affected by a public calamity; and

WHEREAS, the Limestone County Commission has been requested by the Director of the Limestone County Emergency Management Agency to proclaim the existence of a local emergency therein; and

WHEREAS, the County Commission does hereby find that conditions of extreme peril to the safety of the citizens has arisen within Limestone County, caused by the appearance of the 2019 novel coronavirus known as COVID-19 commencing on or about 11 am on the 13th day of March, 2020; and

THAT the aforesaid conditions of extreme peril warrant and necessitate the proclamation of the existence of a local emergency;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY PROCLAIMED that a local emergency now exists throughout Limestone County; and

IT IS FURTHER PROCLAIMED AND ORDERED that during the existence of the local emergency, the powers, functions, and duties of the Director of the Limestone County Emergency Management Agency and the emergency organizations of this County shall be those prescribed by state law, by charter, ordinances, and resolutions of this County approved by the County Commission in March 1965.
