

**MINUTES, LIMESTONE COUNTY COMMISSION, MAY 18, 2020
WORK SESSION**

The Limestone County Commission reconvened the meeting from May 4, 2020 at 9:00 a.m. today at the Clinton Street Courthouse Annex, 100 South Clinton Street, Athens, Alabama.

Present: Daryl Sammet, Steve Turner, and Ben Harrison. Absent: Jason Black. Collin Daly, Chairman presided.

License Commissioner Joseph Cannon explained the Credit/Debit Card Processing Agreement with GovtPortal. He said this is the same company that is used for online tag renewals and registration. The rate will be the same as the previous provider and there will be no cost to the county.

County Engineer Marc Massey discussed the ALDOT Federal Aid Project for resurfacing Shaw Road in District 3. He said this is the end of the Federal Aid as we know it and Commissioner Black will be spending a portion of Rebuild Alabama Act Funds on the project. He expects the project to be let by the end of the month.

County Engineer Marc Massey said the Memorandum of Agreement with ALDOT is for federal aid exchange. Each October 1st the county will receive Rebuild Alabama Act Funds in the amount of \$400,000 in exchange for the annual \$533,000 federal allocation.

Commissioner Steve Turner requested to add the following personnel action to the agenda. Approve to hire Logan Mitchell as a part-time Laborer in District 2, pending drug screening.

Commissioner Ben Harrison requested to add the following inventory changes to the agenda. Approve to Sell on GovDeals: Dresser A550 Motor Grader, inventory tag 17559, serial number 100269; and Galion Dresser2-6T Roller, inventory tag 17797, serial number 614861986.

Items were discussed for the May 4, 2020 commission meeting agenda.

Commissioner Turner announced the Engineering Paving Crew is working on Copeland and Sanderson Roads. They are trying to finish the turn lane at Nick Davis Road and Sanderson Road.
