

**MINUTES, LIMESTONE COUNTY COMMISSION, JUNE 15, 2020
WORK SESSION**

The Limestone County Commission reconvened the meeting from June 2, 2020 at 9:00 a.m. today at the Clinton Street Courthouse Annex, 100 South Clinton Street, Athens, Alabama.

Present: Daryl Sammet, Steve Turner, Jason Black, and Ben Harrison. Absent: None. Collin Daly, Chairman presided.

Richard Martin, 19184 Compton Street, Elkmont, came before the commission asking if the Limestone County Sign Department could make and install a historical sign for the west portion of New Garden Cemetery. The Commissioners agreed to add to today's agenda.

Items were discussed for today's agenda. Commission Harrison discussed the possibility of coming up with a better way to appoint a member of the commission to serve on the ACCA Legislative Committee. Commissioner Turner discussed housekeeping issues that were not being taken care of by Hyde Homes on the construction of Bowman Acres subdivision.

Commissioner Turner reported his district was doing good on a Rebuild Alabama project on Capshaw and Sanderson Roads until the truck broke down; however, Reed Contractors managed to get Sanderson Road resurfaced and it looks great.

Commissioner Black reported his district is reclaiming a portion of Snake Road that runs from Seven-Mile Post Road to Shaw Road. He said they are going to make the road safer and a little bit smoother. His district will be hauling rock and slag for chip sealing most of the week.

Commissioner Harrison reported his district is working on County Line Road installing cross drains, side drains, and pulling ditches. He said County Line Road is a joint project with Lauderdale County; District 4 is doing the prep work and Lauderdale County will apply the plant mix.

Chairman Daly said the project with Lauderdale County is another example of all counties working together. He thanked everyone for attending.
