

**MINUTES, LIMESTONE COUNTY COMMISSION, OCTOBER 5, 2020  
WORK SESSION**

The Limestone County Commission reconvened the meeting from September 21, 2020 at 9:00 a.m. today at the Clinton Street Courthouse Annex, 100 South Clinton Street, Athens, Alabama.

Present: Daryl Sammet, Steve Turner, Jason Black, and Ben Harrison. Absent: None. Collin Daly, Chairman presided.

Richard Martin and David Malone with Limestone County Community Association, a 501 (c) 3 organization, addressed the commission requesting an appropriation in the amount of \$5,000 to assist in matching funds to apply for a grant to complete the Fort Henderson Memorial. Mr. Martin said the project for Fort Henderson is estimated at \$300,000 and will bring tourism to the county. Mr. Malone thanked the commissioners for their previous support and Commissioner Black for his assistance with parking.

Jeff Woods, 26688 Cedar Break Tail, addressed the commission opposing the replat of Lot 13 in East Limestone Acres Subdivision. He read a restriction from the covenant. County Engineer Marc Massey said the county doesn't regulate covenants and restrictions, and the replat of Lot 13 meets the county's regulations to subdivide. County Attorney Mark Maclin added that the county doesn't get involved in a matter between property owners, legal action or whatever is between them.
