

**MINUTES, LIMESTONE COUNTY COMMISSION, JANUARY 4, 2021
WORK SESSION**

The Limestone County Commission reconvened the meeting from December 21, 2021 at 9:00 a.m. today at the Clinton Street Courthouse Annex, 100 South Clinton Street, Athens, Alabama.

Present: Daryl Sammet, Danny Barksdale, Jason Black and LaDon Townsend. Absent: None. Collin Daly, Chairman, presided.

Public comments were made by Brian Jasper with Jeff Martin Auctioneers and Russ Wood with J.M. Wood Auction Co. Inc. Both were there to make comments regarding the upcoming proposal to sell equipment at auction.

Items were discussed for the January 4, 2021 commission meeting agenda.

As to the reason for the rescinding of Bid #2738, the Chairman explained that Blink Marketing was going to charge an additional fee for the printing of the county logo.

Also, No. 1 under "Personnel Actions" was dismissed for any action until further notice.

During the engineering report, discussion occurred about the possible need to purchase a new trailer in the near future.

The Chairman explained why Plan B from J.M. Wood Auction Co. Inc. seemed to be a more secure option for the selling of the equipment at the March 16-20 auction.

Commissioner Barksdale discussed his further review of garbage fees and impact fees. Commissioner Barksdale stated, "Limestone County Water and Sewer Authority adds a \$1,000.00 impact fee for every new hookup, and that is for the impact that it has on their system. District 2 has 600 houses that are going to be built on Capshaw Road which is probably going to necessitate a red light or possibly a turn lane, and I'll have to make a decision unless we can get the developers to do that." Mr. Barksdale further commented that the impact fee would be a help towards money for roads.
