

MINUTES, LIMESTONE COUNTY COMMISSION, NOVEMBER 1, 2017

The Limestone County Commission reconvened the meeting from October 16, 2017 at 10:00 a.m. today at the Washington Street Courthouse Annex, 310 West Washington Street, Athens, AL.

Present: Steve Turner, Jason Black, and Ben Harrison. Absent: Stanley Hill (Hip surgery). Mark Yarbrough, Chairman presided.

Corey Craig, of Roadside Inc., gave an update on the county spraying program and recommended changing from three sprayings per year to just two sprayings for the upcoming year.

Commissioner Turner stated five culvert extensions are being installed on Pepper Road to improve safety.

Commissioner Harrison discussed the increased cost to maintain county roads. He referenced the pamphlet, "The Silent Crisis" published by the Association of County Commissions of Alabama, stating that it cost 9.2 million per year to maintain road surfaces and the County receives 1.2 million. Commissioner Harrison stated he would like to discuss in further detail new ways to pay for road projects and equipment when Commissioner Hill has returned from surgery.

Items were discussed for the November 6, 2017 agenda.
