MINUTES, LIMESTONE COUNTY COMMISSION, DECEMBER 21, 2020 WORK SESSION

The Limestone County Commission reconvened the meeting from December 7, 2020 at 9:00 a.m. today at the Clinton Street Courthouse Annex, 100 South Clinton Street, Athens, Alabama.

Present: Daryl Sammet, Danny Barksdale, Jason Black, and LaDon Townsend. Absent: None. Collin Daly, Chairman presided.

Items were discussed for the December 21, 2020 commission meeting agenda.
