

**MINUTES, LIMESTONE COUNTY COMMISSION, FEBRUARY 1, 2021  
WORK SESSION**

The Limestone County Commission reconvened the meeting from January 19, 2021 at 9:00 a.m. today at the Clinton Street Courthouse Annex, 100 South Clinton Street, Athens, Alabama.

Present: Daryl Sammet, Danny Barksdale and LaDon Townsend. Absent: Jason Black Collin Daly, Chairman presided.

Items were discussed for the February 1, 2021 commission meeting agenda.

Chairman Daly explained that Tony Gravier retired at the end of January and the appointee has been doing a lot of the work. With both the judicial system and funding being down, it was decided that this was the best option in order to see how the Court system proceeds. There is no money swap for the interim to get the position, and we will start taking applications in about three months.

Chairman Daly explained that the State law states that you can attend the police academy at the age of 19, but our job description states the applicant must be at least the age of 21. This will allow our job description to match the law and allow younger applicants the opportunity to apply for the deputy positions.

Add transfer of Melissa McGlocklin from Tag Clerk to Title Clerk in the License Commission Department, to the agenda.

At the next commission meeting, the Chairman hopes to bring together a plan for Cowford Campground which would involve the maintenance department.

Add to amend the Staffing Plan, to the agenda.

As an addition to the agenda for today's meeting, Marc Massey discussed the contracts submitted by IVM Solutions for herbicide spraying, and it was determined that it could be placed on today's meeting under "Contracts, Agreements and Grants."

The Chairman explained that the amended "Commission Meeting Schedule" would clarify that if a work session and meeting was held on a holiday, then the next day after the holiday would be the next scheduled date for the work session and meeting.

It was discussed that District 1 needs to add to today's meeting agenda a 2000 International 4000 series truck to be sold on GovDeals.

Commissioner Sammet, Commissioner Barksdale, Commissioner Townsend and Chairman Collin Daly had no comments.
