

**MINUTES, LIMESTONE COUNTY COMMISSION, JUNE 7, 2022,  
WORK SESSION**

The Limestone County Commission reconvened the meeting from May 16, 2022 at 9:00 a.m. at the Clinton Street Courthouse Annex, 100 South Clinton Street, Athens, Alabama.

Present: Daryl Sammet, Danny Barksdale, Jason Black, and LaDon Townsend. Absent: None. Collin Daly, Chairman presided.

Bobbi Bailey, Director of Limestone County Elections, addressed the Commission requesting a raise for election poll workers. The Commission commended all of the election workers for a job well done.
