

**MINUTES, LIMESTONE COUNTY COMMISSION, JULY 5, 2022
WORK SESSION**

The Limestone County Commission reconvened the meeting from June 21, 2022 at 9:00 a.m. at the Clinton Street Courthouse Annex, 100 South Clinton Street, Athens, Alabama.

Present: Daryl Sammet, Danny Barksdale, Jason Black, and LaDon Townsend. Absent: None. Collin Daly, Chairman presided.

Betty Ruth from the Retired Senior Volunteer Program (RSVP) addressed the Commission regarding RSVP's FY22-23 appropriation request.

Bryan Lorge addressed the Commission regarding his concerns surrounding the Athens-Limestone Animal Shelter.

Items were discussed for today's commission meeting agenda.

Commissioner Black expressed his disagreement with adding a Recycling Department at this time due to his lack of knowledge regarding same. After extensive discussion with the Commission and the Chairman, it was decided to remove number 8 and number 10 from the meeting agenda. Number 8 and 10 stated as follows: "8. Amend Staffing Plan to add a Recycling Department."; "10. Approve job description for Recycling Specialist."

During the Engineer's Report, Engineer Massey addressed the Commission regarding his plan to go ahead and advertise for another engineer, but the position is not currently in his budget and would have to be added to the next budget.
