You are invited to bid on the above specifications. Any substitutes offered must be submitted in detail. The right to reject any items or materials not of quality or under any provisions of this act is reserved.

Bids will be opened on **Tuesday**, the **14<sup>th</sup>** day of **March 2023**, at **10:00 a.m.** and awarded on **Monday**, the **20<sup>th</sup>** day of **March 2023**, at **10:00 a.m.**

**REQUIREMENT:** Pursuant to Alabama Code 31-13-9, as a condition of the award of any contract, the business entity or employer, and any of its subcontractors, shall provide a sworn affidavit and documentation that it will not knowingly employ, hire for employment, or continue to employ an unauthorized alien; that it is enrolled in the E-Verify program; and, during the contract period, it will participate in the E-Verify program and will verify every employee that is required to be verified under applicable state and federal laws. During the performance of the contract, the business entity or employer shall participate in the E-Verify program and shall verify every employee that is required to be verified according to the applicable federal rules and regulations.

### **Miscellaneous Bid Notes**

Bids made out in pencil will not be accepted. Brand names, catalog numbers, etc. are used to indicate levels of quality. If the bidder is unable to furnish an item as specified and desires to offer a substitute, provide a full description of the item, including descriptive literature and/or manufacturer's specifications, along with any supplemental additional information necessary to compare the item bid with the requirements set forth in the bid form, or the bid may be rejected. Any attachment hereto is made and becomes a part of this inquiry and must be signed by bidder. No errors will be corrected after bids are opened. No prices shall include State or Federal Excise Taxes. Tax exemption certificates will be furnished upon request.

Limestone County reserves the right to accept or reject all bids or any portion thereof.

The bidder agrees to furnish the items described in this bid document at the prices shown and guarantee that each item offered will meet or exceed all specifications, conditions and requirements listed for same. The term of this bid is for one year (April 1, 2023 through March 31, 2024)

Unless otherwise agreed upon, the bidder shall begin work no later than 20 days after the work order has been submitted. Work shall be prosecuted in a continuous manner until completion. In the event, work has not started within 20 working days and/or work is not prosecuted in a diligent and continuous manner, the bid may be canceled and placed with the bidder whose price is the next acceptable bid above the lowest acceptable bid received. The difference in cost accrued in the change from the bid price to the next acceptable bid price above that of the low bidder may be charged as liquidated damages to the bidder failing to accomplish the work as described above, except where delays are due to causes beyond the control of the contractor.

Contractor will be responsible for traffic control and protection of the placed material from traffic.

All materials furnished and installation of said materials shall comply with the State of Alabama Department of Transportation Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2018 Edition and to the ALDOT Special and Standard Highway Drawings, (Latest Edition). Special attention is directed to Section 630.00 of the Specifications.

The price bid for the anchors and guardrail shall be full compensation for furnishing all materials, equipment, tools, labor, and incidentals necessary to complete removal and installation according to section 630.03 of the Specifications. Payment shall be made under section 630.05 of the Specifications.

All material testing, certifications, test reports, etc. as required by the Specifications shall be provided by the contractor to the Limestone County Engineering Department.

Any salvageable materials shall remain property of Limestone County Commission.

Quantities are estimates for determining low bidder only. Actual quantities to be placed will vary significantly from quantities shown. Bid will be awarded to one contractor based on the lowest total bid for all items based on the estimated quantities.
