

## PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION CAREFULLY.

Residents are asked to strictly adhere to these rules to ensure this service remains available to the community. Non-compliance causes unnecessary work and expense to the recycling department, and cameras will be onsite to ensure rules are followed. The recycling drop-off is for residents only. We cannot accept business or commercial recycling at the moment.

Start Date: Monday, April 3, 2023

**Location:** 1301 N. Jefferson St. (just south of Elm Street) NO OTHER LOCATIONS are currently available for drop-off.

**Hours of Operation:** 7 am - 3 pm Monday through Thursday ONLY. Gates will be locked outside of these hours and anyone dumping will be prosecuted. Drop off center will be monitored with cameras.

**Please Recycle Correctly:** All materials <u>must be sorted</u> and placed in the appropriately marked recycling containers. <u>Bring only materials that are specifically listed as being accepted.</u> Leaving items like swimming pools, children's toys, any type of glass, trash, furniture, or other items currently not listed as being accepted will cause undue labor and expense, and will be treated as illegal dumping.

## **Items Currently Accepted:**

- **Aluminum Cans** (Call ahead if you have aluminum other than cans)
- **Metal Cans** (Call ahead if you have metal other than cans)
- Plastic Bottles and Jars #1 and #2 ONLY. NO OTHER PLASTICS.
- Mixed Paper
- Cardboard and Paperboard (cereal boxes, drink cartons, etc.)
- ABSOLUTELY NO GLASS OF ANY KIND
